Dr. Mendoza is also the founder and president of PedEM, PLLC, an independent, physician-owned pediatric emergency medicine practice that staffs the Baptist Children's Hospital Emergency Department in Miami, part of Baptist Health South Florida. Fernando also serves as Medical Director of the Baptist Children's Hospital Emergency Center and is Associate Chief of Pediatrics at Baptist Children's Hospital.
